This competition is for students 4th through 8th grade, and the school winner goes on to a local competition, with the possibility of competing at the state level, and then in Washington DC.

The teachers and students have been working hard through the Normalization period, and the majority of the classrooms are ready for parent volunteers. We cherish our parent helpers who can take individual students aside to listen to them read, or give spelling tests to a small group, plus many other areas of support for the class and the teacher.

The challenge for the Orangevale Campus is space, particularly storage. Below is a fun picture of Ms Jordyn, one of our fabulous tech people, who sat herself in our “spider closet” (a nickname for our storeroom from the beginning days of the campus). Jordyn was working on labeling and entering the library books into the new web-based system. (I took a picture, then moved her into the office 😊).

Since we do not have a library, we are excited to have this new program so we can have a *virtual library*. Students and staff will access the site, look for a book, then check them out. Parent volunteers will get the books from the storeroom and deliver them to the appropriate people.

We have ordered a second storage unit to hold items that do not require a locked room, such as PE & recess equipment, Harvest Festival games, etc. This will open up the “spider closet” to allow the library books to be organized for easier access.
