

Tiered Reengagement Strategies

As outlined in Ed Code 43504 as established via Senate Bill 98, CMP is required to develop written procedures for tiered reengagement strategies for students who are absent from distance learning for more than three school days or 60% of the instructional days in a school week.

CMP has created a process and a flow chart to show the process in a graphic format.

This process was put into place, beginning August 31, 2020. Teachers received the flow chart to help guide the tracking of student's engagement.

Process:

Tier I - Attendance AAs and Teachers will be involved

- Attendance AAs will make calls to families of absent students each day, as normal process
 - As part of the call, AAs will inquire the reason for lack of engagement
 - For device or connectivity issues – contact IT and let them know this family needs support
 - For parent work schedule issues or students have a consistent need to do their learning during non-school hours – contact your admin team to develop a written attendance action plan with the family for completion of work so all parties are on the same page
 - For social emotional issues – contact the Counseling department and let them know this family/student needs support
- At the end of each week after attendance (or Monday for the week prior), AAs will identify who has 3 or more unverified/unexcused absences via the Student with Absences report in Aeries
 - Attendance AAs will contact teachers of students on the list so they know to follow up with families
 - Attendance AAs will also provide this report to Deans/Principals for review/reference each week as they will be working with families in the next tiers as needed

Tier II – If a student has two instances of missing three days (or 60%) of the week, Deans will contact the family to offer assistance, support and potentially start an SST process

Tier III – If a student has three instances of missing three days (or 60%) of the week, the Principal will initiate the SART process

Tier IV – If a student has four instances of missing three days (or 60%) of the week, Deans/Principals will request a well check or contact social/health services
