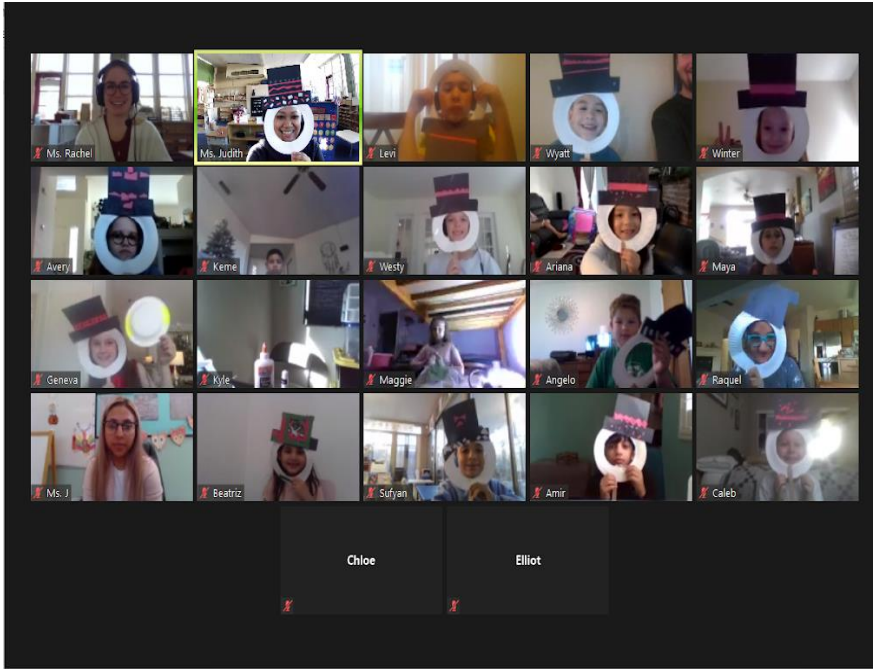
## COMMENTS

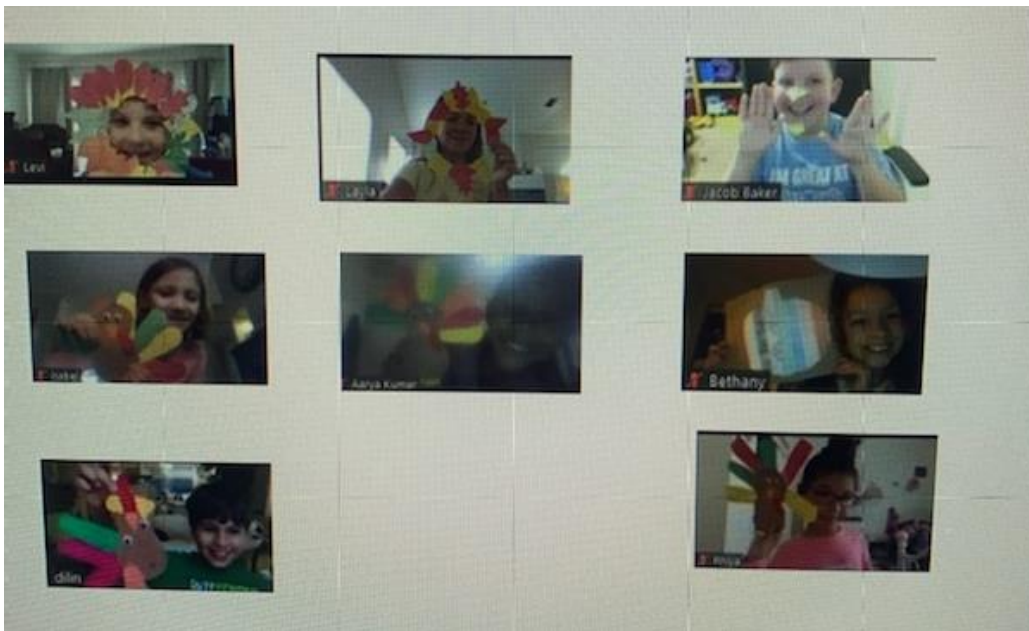
