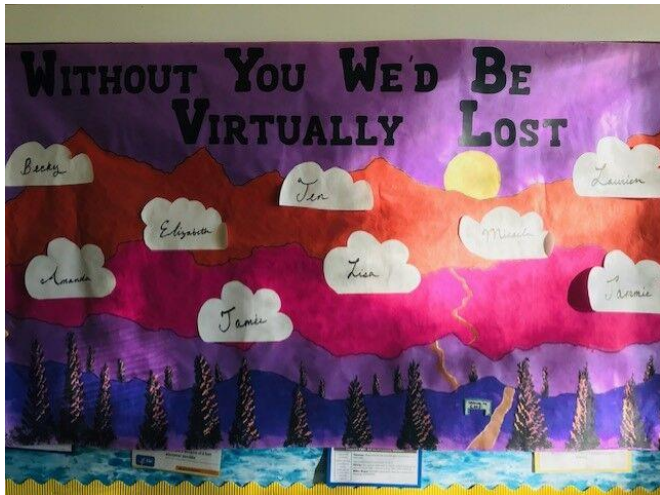
COMMENTS:

Our Read-A-Thon closed on October 30th and raised \$8536.00 for our school library - a record amount for this annual event! With these funds, \$3051.81 will be used to increase titles in our digital library (an additional 157 books). We will also purchase 294 physical books (cost of \$3167). Over half of the digital and physical books being purchased are non-fiction, including books about sports, health, crafts, world history, cultures, books on different eras, and biographies. Lastly, \$2000 of the funds have been earmarked to purchase STEM projects and resources for students to utilize in the library (coding, robotics, engineering, and maker space tools).

We are thrilled to see such success in our community’s use of the Sora Digital Library! We launched the program on November 12. Since then, we have had over 600 books checked out and our students are averaging 50 minutes of reading a day – which is wonderful! In addition to our digital library, we created a library website that contains read-along videos and daily activities to help support our teachers and students during distance learning. Since November 1, we have generated over 16,000 visits to our read-a-long videos and Library Website. A huge thank you to our community for your incredible support of the Read-A-Thon and the literacy resources it generates for our students!

On another note, the CMP Carmichael team returned from Thanksgiving break to an incredible surprise from our families: a campus filled with heart-warming messages of gratitude, reminders of the difference they make every day, and well wishes for the season. Banners filled our hallways, greeted staff at Central Admin, and were tucked into unexpected locations throughout the campus. Every day they remind us of the strong connection we have to the students and parents (though we are apart), the deep appreciation felt for our teachers, staff and Board, and how much our community values CMP. Thank you to our families such heartfelt, creative, inspiring messages!!!
