Though it was a short month, December 2020 was busy at CMP-Carmichael. Our students completed their second diagnostic in iReady, which enables teachers to monitor student progress in reading and math skills and tailor instruction, accordingly. We are excited by the growth we see in our students!

Teachers and staff completed Acts on Facts training, which supports the social/emotional well-being of our students by educating about risks of self-harm/suicidal thoughts and behaviors in elementary and middle school students. Staff meetings this month will include follow up information from our school counselor.

The week prior to winter break, teachers focused on classroom preparations to ensure their readiness for the hybrid learning model. They have done great work adjusting their environments so they conform to public health guidelines, while continuing to be the beautiful, inviting Montessori spaces we are so proud of. We continue to be holding month fundraisers to support the classrooms with needed materials and greatly appreciate the generosity that has been demonstrated by our community.

Our school community was invited to participate in our first “Sharks Have Talent!” Students sent in clips to highlight their amazing talents, which were compiled into a video and shared with our families and staff on December 18<sup>th</sup>.
