COMMENTS

Our CMP Shingle Springs Community has been exceptionally generous during our Giving Tuesday drive. We set a goal of raising \$10,000 for additional Montessori Classroom Materials and throughout the month of December we watched our donations continue to grow, reaching a very impressive **\$9,499!** Teachers have been excited to turn in their requests for additional materials so that we have plenty to keep our shelves stocked with beautiful Montessori materials, minimizing the need for so much cleaning and disinfecting in between uses during the school day.

Our students continue to be very happy to be back on campus. The teachers frequently express their sentiments that smaller cohorts create a very close and tight-knit classroom community. We are seeing a lot more cooperation and collaboration. There are fewer behavioral issues. Teachers and TA's report that they are able to deliver more individual and small group lessons due to the smaller class sizes. We're also seeing that the more children are on campus, the healthier they are both socially and emotionally. There are indeed challenges as we follow strict protocols and have staff isolating and quarantining, creating substitute needs beyond our current capacity.
